

RESOLUTION 20230920

A resolution of the Sanibel Fire and Rescue District of Lee County, Florida, adopting the final levying of Ad Valorem Taxes for Lee County for Fiscal Year 2023-2024; providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the Sanibel Fire and Rescue District of Lee County, Florida, on September 20, 2023, adopted the final millage rate for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 following a public hearing as required by Florida Statute 200.065.

WHEREAS, the Sanibel Fire and Rescue District of Lee County, Florida, held a public hearing as required by Florida Statutes 200.065.

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within Lee County has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the Sanibel Fire and Rescue District as \$4,217,789,351.00; the following resolution is hereby adopted:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the COMMISSIONERS OF THE SANIBEL FIRE AND RESCUE DISTRICT BOARD of Lee County, Florida, that the documents attached hereto, will be made part of this resolution, and indicates the following:

THE FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024 OPERATING MILLAGE RATE FOR SANIBEL FIRE AND RESCUE DISTRICT IS SET AT 1.4000 MILLS, WHICH EXCEEDS THE ROLL-BACK RATE OF 1.1061 MILLS RESULTING IN A TAX PERCENTAGE INCREASE TO RESIDENTS OF THE DISTRICT OF 26.57%, PROVIDING FOR PROCEEDS OF \$5,904,905.09.

THIS RESOLUTION SHALL TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY UPON ITS ADOPTION.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Sanibel Fire and Rescue District duly adopted at a public hearing this, the 20th Day of September 2023.
