Commissioner Lawrence opened the meeting at 8:00 AM.

Commissioner Muench led the Pledge of Allegiance.

1st Order of Business: The minutes from the April 11th, 2018, meeting was reviewed and accepted by the Board Members. A motion was made by Commissioner Muench to accept the minutes as presented. The motion was second by Commissioner Cochrane. There was no discussion. The motion was approved unanimously.

2nd Order of Business: The EMS Training for the Month was Pediatric Emergencies. Open Water Swim has been completed. Working with 2 ½" hose deployments, approximately 300 feet worth. For the last 2 months doing rope rescues. CPR Classes are still happening on a monthly schedule.

3rd Order of Business: Assistant Chief Briscoe stated that the calls for April were 160, which was up by 6 from the 154 calls in 2017. We had a landscaper come in and trim all the large trees and remove the stumps at Station 172

4th Order of Business: Fire Marshall Tassoni stated that the City of Sanibel is thinking about doing all their Building Permits through their computer system, making everything paperless. They are building a new Chase Bank on Palm Ridge Road. The Sanibel Library is in Phase 2 of their Building Project. FM Tassoni reviewed the situation with Breakers West on West Gulf Drive, in front of Waterside Inn, refusing to let Waterside Inn use their driveway to access their property.
