

RESOLUTION NO. 25-015

A RESOLUTION OF THE SANIBEL FIRE AND RESCUE DISTRICT, LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE TENTATIVE LEVY OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in compliance with Florida Statutes Section 200.065, the Sanibel Fire and Rescue District Board of Commissioners held a public hearing on September 3, 2025, to adopt the tentative millage rate for Fiscal Year 2025-2026; and

WHEREAS, the Lee County Property Appraiser has certified the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within the District at \$5,635,442,483 ; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Sanibel Fire and Rescue District as follows:

The tentative operating millage rate for Fiscal Year 2026 is set at _____ mills. This represents a _____% increase in ad valorem taxes as compared to the rolled-back rate, as shown on the DR-420, and is expected to generate proceeds of \$ _____.

The final adoption of the District's millage rate and budget will occur on September 16, 2025, at 5:01 PM, at Sanibel Fire and Rescue District Station 171, located at 2351 Palm Ridge Road, Sanibel, Florida 33957.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
