3rd Order of Business: The EMS Training for the month of October, consisted of treatment of strokes and Advanced Cardia Life Support. Still doing drills on the new Ladder 171. The District supply of hose is also being tested this month. It was noted that other counties throughout the State are starting to form MERT Teams - Marine Emergency Response Teams. Several CPR classes have been conducted during the month of October.

4Th Order of Business: Assistant Chief Briscoe stated that the calls for October were at 123, which was up by 2 from the 121 calls in 2017. At this point we are up 102 calls over the 2017 calls. Campbell Roofing, will be repairing the roof at Station 172. Thus far we have received 2 bids for the new Radio Tower at Station 172. Assistant Chief Briscoe also review the brush fire at Island Inn Road, which was a brush fire that consumed a pick-up truck in its path. The Brush Truck (Forestry), will have its pump tested next week, it should be

placed in service after that, Assistant Chief Briscoe also stated that Marine 171, is being serviced at York Marine.
